Hi!

I'm Lionel and I am a jazz guitar player. I play my own music and I perform on stage or in studio as a sideman for various jazz artists such as Becca Stevens, Brad Mehldau or Joshua Redman. I like jazz because it is a universal language that quickly connects musicians together even if they don't speak the same language.



I practice music most of the time. A professional musician doesn't have a typical weekly schedule. For example, this week I'm giving on line guitar lessons on my Youtube live channel and I'm recording some fresh material for a singer called Robin McKelle. Then I play gigs 3 evenings a week in jazz clubs or private concerts.

I'm lucky enough to have enrolled a music high school, which means that my activities are part of my curriculum. I have to attend courses on Monday and Friday but the school has its own studios and rehearsal facilities that make my life easier. We are quite free in the way we manage our study time and I like that.

My family is rather proud of my achievements, especially my father who has always wanted to become a musician himself. My brother and my mother are not so much into jazz music but they enjoy the concerts anyway.

I mostly travel for concerts and recording sessions. Belgium, France, Italy and Spain have great jazz festivals and often welcome foreign musicians to play.

I can't relate to any negative aspect of being famous, but it never lasts forever. People change and music changes as well. People get bored quickly so you have to keep up the pace of evolution. Being a musician is a full-time commitment. My friend Brian Blade who is a drummer says that "you have to eat jazz, to sleep jazz, to drink jazz and to be jazz from dusk 'till dawn". And I think he 's right.
